UCD Classical Museum









- ► Authenticity: replica from original, accuracy, 'ambience', authorisation and copyright → how do we reconcile original + interpretation?
- **♦** Ontology: vision only or also process and substance? → displaying essence?
- ► Embodiment: handling, experimentation → sensitive engagement?
- ► Process: ideological, material, inter-material → 'process' as practice?
- **Epistemology:** replication of certain finds and exhibits perpetuates specific representations of the past and its display → reflexivity, critique, de-colonisation?
- **Identity:** archaeological, professional, institutional, museological, political, national, ethnic, commercial → representation, ethics, value, freedom of speech?



- ♣ Authenticity: how do we reconcile original + interpretation? → new insights into material (original and replicas), breaking down of dualisms.
- ► Ontology: displaying essence? → moving away from straightforward, quick fixes, exploring multiple constructs (physical and notional) and roles of objects.
- ► Embodiment: sensitive engagement? → embodiment in research and display.
- ▶ Process: 'process' as practice? → in-depth exploration of identities (including of artefacts and practitioners), reflexivity on exhibition as a process
- ► Epistemology: reflexivity, critique, de-colonisation? → innovation in the exhibition approach, critique of discourses, publication of academic + experimental research results.
- ► *Identity*: representation, ethics, value, freedom of speech? → voicing of different narratives; meaningful internationalisation of the collection.
